Title IX Compliance and Coordinator Information

Pursuant to Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972 and the U.S. Department of Education's implementing regulations at 34 C.F.R. Part 106, the Meskwaki Settlement School's Title IX Coordinator has primary responsibility for coordinating Meskwaki Settlement School efforts to comply with and carry out its responsibilities under Title IX, prohibiting sex discrimination in all operations of the Meskwaki Settlement School, as well as retaliation for the purpose of interfering with any right or privilege secured by Title IX.

Sexual misconduct against students, including sexual harassment, sexual assault, rape, and sexual exploitation, can be a form of sex discrimination under Title IX. The Title IX coordinator oversees the response of the Meskwaki Settlement School to reports and complaints of possible sex discrimination to monitor outcomes, identify and address any patterns, and assess effects on the campus climate, so the Meskwaki Settlement School can address issues that affect the wider school community.

A student should contact the Title IX Coordinator in order to:

- seek information or training about students' rights and courses of action available to resolve reports or complaints that involve potential sex discrimination, including sexual misconduct,
- file a complaint or make a report of sex discrimination, including sexual misconduct,
- notify the Meskwaki Settlement School of an incident or policy or procedure that may raise potential Title IX concerns,
- get information about available resources (including confidential resources) and support services relating to sex discrimination, including sexual misconduct, and
- ask questions about the Meskwaki Settlement School's policies and procedures related to sex discrimination, including sexual misconduct.
