**Goal #1:
Staff Evaluation**
As a collaborative effort for ongoing professional improvement, all staff shall be evaluated at the Meskwaki Settlement School.



Evaluation Process
An evaluation process for administrators, managers, teachers, and support staff designed to create a collaborative approach to professional improvement will be developed and implemented.

**Goal #2:
Data-Driven Decision Making**
To support student learning needs, assessments will be used to analyze students performance and inform instruction.



Teacher Training
Using data from the summative and formative assessments, teachers will review student learning needs and utilize this information to inform instruction.

**Goal #3:
Curriculum**
Reevaluate current curriculum, align with the Iowa Core (IC) and BIE Standards and recommend improvements to the Board of Education.



Curriculum Review Cycle
Develop and implement a four year Curriculum Review Cycle to guide scope and sequence alignment PK-12.

**Goal #4:
Technology**
To provide the facilities, infrastructure, & access to technology necessary to support high student achievement in a safe, healthy environment.



Technology Initiative
To initiate integration of technology training on applications and utilization in the instructional setting to enhance student learning and technology skills.

**Goal #5:
Language Program**
Supervise and assist in the development of the Meskwaki Language Program in collaboration with the Language Coordinator.



Language Program Assessment
To develop an assessment and determine the effectiveness of the Meskwaki 3-year old Language Program.
